



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RATINGS AND CHARACTERISTICS CURVES ($T_A = 25$ °C unless otherwise noted)




Fig. 1 - Maximum Forward Current Derating Curve





Fig. 2 - Average Power Loss Characteristics









Fig. 4 - Typical Reverse Leakage Characteristics







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




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Copper Pad Areas





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
