






On-Resistance vs. Drain Current








On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




**Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage** 



On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage






**Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature**


Safe Operating Area
